The ILF Academy offers all employees the opportunity to gain personal and social expertise which is a prerequisite for successful, high-quality project work.





In keeping with the IMS process group 3.1 all staff development measures shall be discussed and determined in the annual staff appraisal interview and subsequently outlined in the performance planning and review process.

In addition to complying with the registration guidelines of the ILF Academy, please consider local ILF policies for training.

Costs

The ILF Academy is an internal institution but will still generate costs such as trainer fees, development and administration costs that have to be covered.

The fees are:

EUR 250 per 0.5 training day EUR 500 per 1.0 training day EUR 750 per 1.5 training days EUR 1000 per 2.0 training days

These training fees include the costs for trainers (with ILF training instructors covering only working hours), catering and training material. These fees are considerably more competitive compared to external learning providers.
